USPS Boating Skills Virtual Trainer (BSVT) - Key facts

- The **Boating Skills Virtual Trainer (BSVT)** is a USPS training unit funded by a grant by the U.S. Coast Guard. The BSVT is shipped in 3 Pelican cases and features:
 - Three 20" monitors
 - A steering wheel featuring horn and trim tab controls
 - Throttle
 - Buttons on steering wheel to expand the vision field to the left or right for 225 degree visibility
- Important for setting up the unit at a show: Table lip must not exceed 1.5" and must have a clear lip underneath in order for the clamps to hold properly.
- The unit has the following exercises built in:
 - Docking
 - Slalom Course
 - Crossing/Overtaking other vessels(both sail and power)
 - Departing dock
 - Spring lines
 - Maneuvering in Fairways
 - Pivot Turn
 - Mooring
 - Emergency Stop
 - Trim control in throttle
 - Night maneuvers with crossing/overtaking lights
 - Controls to change current and wind direction and strength
- The virtual lake is 3 miles x 4 miles and the virtual boat can travel at will all over the lake. Exercises begin at certain points on the lake and are designed to be instructor-led.
- Next steps: Grant two funding will pay for seven additional units to be released in 2014 with Generation one functionality. Generation two development is underway to add (1) 360 degree visibility, (2) impact of stern wake from other vessels, (3) multi-lingual, (4) timers, (5) position on the lake, (6) navigation aids for piloting. Gen two units will be debuted at 2015 USPS annual meeting in Jacksonville in January 2015, afterwhich all units in the field will be upgraded to Gen 2.

Internal cost for USPS/CGA/CPS is \$14,900 plus shipping in temporary boxes. External organizations may purchase a unit for \$18,900 plus shipping. Permanent Pelican shipping cases may be purchased separately for \$1850.
