

The Atlantic hurricane season doesn't start until June, but the Caller Times ran a front page story Sunday about Hurricane storm surges. I guess awareness is not a part time thing.

They state a Category 5 hurricane with a large storm surge could damage nearly \$4.7 billion of residential property in the Corpus Christi area. Even a Category 1 hurricane could produce more than \$828 million of damage to 5,200 homes. Those figures are from a study by First American Co., a large company that offers title and specialty insurance and property information. First American chose Corpus Christi and 12 other coastal cities to study because of their vulnerability to hurricanes and the probability that a storm could strike. Other areas included Brownsville, New Orleans, Myrtle Beach, S.C., and Tampa, Fla. The study included only residential property. Click here to see the just released First American 2010 storm surge report. This is WAY more information than you ever wanted to know, but the Corpus Christi estimated surge elevations are interesting (page 8).

I was extremely happy to see so many people turn out for the Change of Watch. Everyone had a good time, and the squadron received many awards. Thanks again to everyone who made those awards possible.

April Recipe

- 1/2 (8 ounce) package Monterey Jack cheese, cut into strips
- 20 large shrimp peeled, deveined and butterflied
- 10 slices bacon, cut in half

Preheat the oven to 450 degrees F (220 degrees C).

Place a small piece of cheese into the butterflied opening of each shrimp. Wrap half of a slice of bacon around each one to conceal the cheese, securing with toothpicks. Place on a cookie sheet.

Bake for 10 to 15 minutes in the preheated oven, until bacon is browned.
