North America's Safe Boating Week has ended; but **Boating Safely** has not. Safe Boating is most important to all boaters. As members of America's Boating Club of Kennebec River, we need to help other boaters to be safe.

Help comes in many forms, such as sharing our knowledge and our experiences, and setting a good example on and off the water. If you see something unsafe, take a minute and approach the boater. Help them understand and show them how to correct the problem.

A proper fitting Life Jacket (PFD) is a must for all boaters. Make sure you have the right PFD for the boater's type and make sure it has USCG approval. Remember there is a Youth size PFD that is excellent for the tall, thin frame of a pre-teen.

Special PFDs are available and should be used for Kayakers, canoeists, paddle boarders and personal watercraft users. Make sure the proper PFD is worn.

Maine and Federal Regulations state that Inflatable PFDs CANNOT be worn by anyone 16 yrs of age and younger. PFDs MUST be worn by 13 yr. olds and younger on coastal and tidal waters. This includes tidal waters like the Kennebec River. In fresh water, regulations state 10 yr olds and younger MUST wear a properly fitting life jacket.
