

Findley Lake covers 83 acres of water. The north end of the lake is fairly deep, with depths measured to 21 feet. The southern end of the lake is relatively shallow, with depths measuring generally less than six feet.

Hand-powered vessels and boats with electric motors are permitted on the lake. Two launch ramps, each with floating kayak launch ramps, provide access (the Main Boat ramp is located on the west side of the lake; the other ramp is in the campground). Between Memorial Day and Labor Day, kayaks and canoes can be rented Mondays and Friday-Sunday from the beach concession.


*Findley Lake was constructed by the Ohio Division of Parks. The earthen dam was built during 1954 and 1955, with the gates closed in April 1956.*


All of our inspectors have been certified and are waiting for your call.




#### THE DESK OF YOUR TREASURER SECRETARY
