

They are then either forwarded to the Chief Commander for approval or returned to me for additional justification. National Merit Mark guidelines require my subjective submissions include descriptions and examples clearly identifying a member's "significant & specific personal efforts and time commitment." Attending District conferences as a delegate, committee chairmanships, serving on committees, assisting in squadron social events, cooperative charting and participation in Safe Boating Week are just some examples of personal contributions fulfilling

Merit Mark criteria. Objectively speaking however, performing 10 VSC's will undoubtedly qualify you for a Merit Mark. Attending general membership meetings, while considered exemplary & commendable, is not considered sufficient activity, "in itself," to be bestowed with a Merit Mark. It is imperative that you inform me of ALL your contributions & participation in the USPS, namely to our squadron, so that they may be included with my submitted recommendation. The Merit Mark program is an invaluable tool, used by the Chief Commander, as their way of personally "Thanking You" for 'giving back' to the USPS. Volunteer today, and start earning yours!



Note that I need your reservation 5 days before all the stated




- meetings (please contact me so I don't have to contact you)

Our upcoming Governing Board Meeting is in Pittsburgh on September 25th thru 29th. Hope to see you at our next meeting.



You might also talk to Dave B at our own September meeting, for his thoughts on the Governing Board meetings.


